FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

During the Liturgy we sing a beautiful hymn following the reception of Communion while the priest performs the ablutions. The text of this hymn comes from our funerary tradition and is sung during the *ginnaz* celebrated before the burial. The text translates as:

*Because I have consumed your Holy Body may the fire not consume me, and
because I have touched it to my eyes, may they behold, O Lord, Your grace.
Here, O Lord, I have not been a stranger to You, there may I not be an outcast.
Do not set me among the goats, but make me worthy to praise You with the
lambs at Your right hand.*

*You have given me, O Son of God, food for the journey, and when I was hungry
I partook of Your Gift, O Savior of the World. May the fire shrink back from
my members as the perfume of Your Body and Blood drives it from me. May
Your Baptism be for me an unfailing ship to transport me from the region of
fear to the place of the fullness of life.*

While taken from the funeral rites, this hymn has traditionally played a recurring part in our communion rite at the Liturgy in the Maronite tradition. This is a profoundly beautiful reflection on the role the Eucharist has in our path from this World to the Next. This hymn reflects on the human condition – the reference to the senses (taste, smell, etc.) and on the spiritual condition (our proximity or estrangement from God). The Eucharist is described as *viaticum* or “food for the journey” that nourishes us not only in this life on earth but also in the journey from this life to Paradise. This hymn is also demonstrative of Syriac cosmology, where our tradition describes the afterlife as a journey over a lake of fire on the way to paradise. The fragrance of the Eucharist serves as a “shield” that fends off the flames and also prowling demons that seek to take a soul into Gehenna. Baptism serves as our boat across the fire with the Eucharist as our guide and guardian to the place “full of life.”

FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

This week we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy and Life-Giving Cross. This is one of the great feasts of the Church Year. The Feast of the Holy Cross stands out in the Syriac Churches as we dedicate an entire season to the commemoration of the Mystery of the Cross. For this feast during vespers the Church prays:

In the way of my paths they have hidden snares for me. I looked to the right and saw, and there was no one to advise me. A place of refuge was lost for me and there is no avenger for my soul. I have called out to You, Lord, and I said, "You are my hope and my portion in the land of the living."
 (Psalm 142)

Hallelujah! As Moses warred with his foes he depicted for us the great mystery of the saving cross. By it, he smote Amalek. By it, he conquered foes and clothed Israel in a fearsome might. Let us seek refuge in it in true faith for we shall receive from it life that will never die. Let us cry out together, "O Son crucified for us, hallelujah! guard us by Your cross."

This psalm and hymn verse teaches us of the power and victory that the Cross of Christ achieved for our sake. Just as the foreshadowing of the Cross allowed Moses to conquer Pharaoh, Amalek, and the many foes that stood against the Hebrew people, the Cross takes us from the solitude and hopelessness of the Psalmist to the beautiful joy and consolation of Paradise. We need not imagine what the reality of the Cross offers us: "we shall receive from it life that will never die." This is the glory of the Cross!



FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

The last verse of the *mazmooro* sung during the Season of the Holy Cross is a beautiful meditation on the meaning of the Cross of Christ. The musical adaptation in our current missal says, "Lord, your cross is a ladder leading us to heaven's heights. May your Church and her children join the angel hosts on high." This, sadly, is not an accurate rendering of the Syriac original. The Syriac text of this verse says, "Blessed is Your Cross, O Our Savior, which became the ladder of Your Church, and by It [the Cross] mortals ascend and have part with the spiritual beings." This is a stunningly beautiful image and we should use it as our pattern of prayer during this holy season.

"Blessed is Your Cross, O Our Savior..." We praise the instrument of our salvation because without it our sins would not be forgiven. "Which became the ladder of Your Church...." The Cross is Jacob's Ladder by which the graces and mercy of God flow down upon us from Heaven through the ministry of the angelic hosts and the sacramental rites and also the means by which we ascend to heaven through the salvation wrought by Christ for us upon the Cross. "And by It, mortals ascend and have part with the spiritual beings." This tells us that the chasm that existed between the mortal realm of men and the celestial realm of God and His Angels has been *crossed* – by the Cross – pun intended. Mortal man now has access to the celestial realm of God and the angelic hosts through the merciful dispensation of God offered to us through the Cross. We are now able to ascend and transcend this mortal realm and take part in the heavenly worship of the angels. This is a beautiful and powerful message to all of us, we now have hope through the Cross!

The Syriac Churches sing a hymn on Friday night that prays:

Adam instructed his children of what reason he and Eve were called to depart from Paradise. He spoke to them of his former authority and of his fall and his exile when he was shamed. It is not fitting for the foot that ran to the Tree to tread the Holy Place when it is not clean. It is not right for the hand that plucked the fruit in Eden to wave over the Offering of the Lord. Christ, who came and walked on the earth and uprooted its thorns, by you Adam returned to Paradise.

All of us, by birth, are children of Adam. Because of his fall it is not fitting that Adam's children would minister to the Lord in worship. However, because of the Incarnation and because of the Cross, we are not merely children of Adam. All Christians, by the new birth of Baptism, are children of the Father once again. This is why Christians may again offer prayer, sacrifice, and worship to God. Adam walked through the Garden to the Tree and plucked Its Fruit leading to Death. Christ walked upon the Earth to the Tree and became Himself the Fruit that we pluck in the Eucharist leading to Life. May we walk always with the Lord towards the Tree of Life, and not follow the footsteps of our father Adam in his path of disobedience, exile, and shame. For the Cross is our refuge, our protection, and our joy!
