## Letter from our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend we commemorate the beautiful feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord on Mount Tabor that was celebrated this past week. This is the feast by which Christ, through the appearance of Moses and Elijah, demonstrated to the Apostles that his Coming was foretold through the Law and the Prophets. In the *qolo* for this feast we pray,

God, in his great majesty,
was revealed in brilliant light,
He whom Moses once beheld
in the bush ablaze with fire.
Elijah and Moses stood and spoke with him;
lightning filled the sky.
Overcome with fear and awe,
Peter, James, and John bowed down;
a bright cloud appeared,
and the Father's Voice was heard:
"This is my beloved Son, whom I have sent.
He has come to save the world."

The Apostles were shocked to see Elijah and Moses but became even more amazed when the Father revealed the divinity of His Son to them through this appearance. The same Fire that burned the Bush before Moses, and consumed the oblation offered by Elijah, shown forth in the person of Jesus Christ, transfigured before them.

May we also open our hearts to the Light of Christ's Divinity in our own lives. Moses was amazed to see a bush burning with fire but not consumed, the Apostles were amazed to see Christ dazzling with Divine Light, and all of us should be amazed that we too become Burning Bushes when we receive Christ through the sacraments, especially those of Baptism and the Holy Eucharist.

Lord, your face once was hidden; now it shines throughout the world. May our minds be enlightend by your love and peace and light!





#### Appeal to the Nations of the World

Beirut is a devastated city. A catastrophe struck the city because of a mysterious explosion that occurred in its sea port. Beirut, the bride of the East and the lighthouse of the West, is injured. Destruction and desolation are visible in virtually all its streets, neighborhoods, and homes. Hundreds of citizens have lost their lives; thousands are injured. Hospitals, places of worship, residences, public and private institutions, hotels, shopping malls and stores have been totally or partially destroyed.

Many of the city's inhabitants are homeless. This national disaster comes at a time when the country is in a situation of economic and financial bankruptcy which renders the government incapable of facing this human and urban catastrophe. In addition, the Lebanese people are also in a state of poverty and indigence.

The Church, which has set up a relief network throughout Lebanon's territory, today finds itself faced with a new and greater responsibility which she cannot assume alone. This being said, however, the Church stands in total solidarity with the afflicted, the dead and their families, the wounded, and the displaced in placing her institutions at their service.

On behalf of the church in Lebanon, I wish to thank all the states that have expressed their readiness and willingness to aid the devastated city of Beirut. I also take the liberty to address Lebanon's friends throughout the world, especially the super powers, as well as the United Nations, to mobilize their efforts for the purpose of providing immediate aid to save the city of Beirut, without any political considerations, because what has happened is beyond politics and conflict. I also call on charities in different countries to help Lebanese families, the inhabitants of the Beirut in particular, so that they can heal their wounds and restore their homes.

During these last years, Lebanon has not ceased to experience successive political, security, economic and financial catastrophes, which require interventions to save the country. Lebanon, which offered the alphabet to the world, deserves the support of its brothers and friends to help it restore its capital, through the immediate establishment of a fund under UN control to manage aid. I am speaking to you because I know that you love Lebanon and that you will answer this call. I am addressing you because I know how much you want Lebanon to regain its historic role in the service of mankind, democracy, and peace in the middle east and in the world.

Dear Brother Priests, Deacons and Subdeacons, Consecrated Men and Women, Lay Faithful:

In these unprecedented times in which we are living and in light of the recent explosion in Lebanon, I ask that we take this opportunity as an invitation to increase our practices of *fasting*, *prayer and almsgiving*. These three recommended practices are given to us by Christ and the Church to draw us closer to God and one another. Thus, I ask each of you to join me in a special time from the Feast of the Assumption, August 15<sup>th</sup> until the Feast of the Holy Cross, September 14<sup>th</sup>, for a time to increase our Christian generosity by these special spiritual practices.

Let us **pray** for Lebanon and her people. May God have mercy on our dear Lebanon. Let us pray for an end to the pandemic; for the safety, health and well-being of our children, elderly and the vulnerable and for those serving the public good, and those who are in harm's way. Let us pray for the Church, for vocations to the priesthood, religious life, faithful married life, and the generous single life. Let us pray for our world, for a resolution of civil strife, and for political stability, both here and in Lebanon. Let us pray for a renewed appreciation of the innate dignity of each human person, for a deeper solidarity with the poor, for an increased respect for the common good, and for a deeper engagement of all of us in what we call Catholic Social Teaching.

I also ask each of you to join me in a **fast**. Let us add **Wednesdays** to our traditional **Friday** fast. The traditional fast consists of eating nothing before noon, as well as abstaining from meat, eggs and dairy products. But I invite each of you to fast in any way you can on those days. Fasting reminds us that our deepest longing is for God and for his Kingdom to rule over us.

Lastly, I know many of you are already extended beyond your usual means to helping others, but I ask each of you to practice an even greater charity these days in **almsgiving**. This includes your own family members in need, your parish, the poor who are near you, and the poor who are far away. I ask for donations to **Caritas Lebanon** and **Saint Vincent de Paul Society** of Lebanon. This can be done by way of the Eparchy of Saint Maron of Brooklyn with a check payable to the Eparchy of Saint Maron of Brooklyn, 109 Remsen Street, Brooklyn, New York 11201, or a donation made on our website www.stmaron.org.

These unprecedented times call for unprecedented *prayer*, *fasting and almsgiving*. May God hear our prayers and accept what we offer him, so that our world, and we ourselves, can be more just and pleasing to him.



## Letter from our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

In his Homily *On the Mother of God*, St. Jacob of Serug writes, "Through Eve's silence came defeat and disrepute, through Mary's words, Life, Light, and victory." It is opportune for us in these times of uncertainty and anxiety, to reflect upon her life during this holy feast in her honor.

Throughout our lives we are confronted with many challenges, obstacles, and temptations and often through our silence or inaction we allow ourselves and others to succumb to the temptations of the world. Like Eve, we unquestioningly heed the serpent's suggestions, and allow the world to take hold of us. It is our Christian obligation, however, to embrace Mary's loqaciousness rather than Eve's silence! Not only did Mary question Gabriel and enter into dialogue with him at her Annunciation but she then broke into a beautiful hymn of praise to God saying, "My Soul doth magnify the Lord! And my Spirit hath rejoiced in God my Savior!" It is our calling to engage God in dialogue, questions, and discourse through prayer and meditation. Further, we are called to respond to this dialogue with praise!

It is because of this hymn of praise uttered by the lips of Mary that the Lord did receive the soul of the Mother of God upon her death and usher her through the Gates of Paradise! Indeed, Mary's hymn "My Soul doth magnify the Lord!" was made clear to the Apostles when they found the Tomb of Mary to be empty.

It is from the Empty Tomb of Christ that the Apostles went forth the first time and from the Empty Tomb of Mary that the Apostles went forth to complete their apostolic missions. One by one each apostle met death and were laid in a tomb as well. But these men went happily to their tombs because they had seen in the Empty Tomb of Mary the foretaste of what they will experience at the Second Coming.

May we all join in the praise of God offered by Mary: "He hath received Israel His servant, being mindful of His Mercy. As he spoke to our Fathers, to Abraham and his seed forever." Being mindful of the Mercy of God, shown to Mary at her death and promised to us upon our own deaths, let us ask the intercession of the Mother of God that we might be always singing of the mysteries of God with open lips and open hearts in expectation of the Lord's Coming.





## Letter from our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

Throughout the year we celebrate feasts and festivals of our Lord and of the saints. These are accompanied by processions, blessings of crops and fruits, water, and the other elements. We celebrate these feasts with great festivity and joy. Our celebration and jubiliation, however, cannot be limited to great feasts. Our Maronite Liturgy sings the praises of Sunday, the Lord's Day and draws our attention to why the Sunday celebration of the Eucharist is just as important to us as Easter or Christmas. In the *Broodikee*, or diaconal proclamation during the traditional Fraction rite, the deacon sings:

Again and again, through this holy oblation and forgiving sacrifice, presented to God the Father, consecrated, completed, and perfected by the dwelling of the Holy Spirit, let us pray for our father, the offering and consecrating priest, for the altar of God upon which the oblation has been placed, for the blessed assembly that approaches and receives it with a living faith and also for those remembered especially in this oblation. Sunday is the sun shining from on high. Its light eliminates the darkness, and all creatures rejoice. On Sunday, the darkness of ignorance disappears in the light that shone from the tomb, and the whole universe exalts. Sunday is the day of the Lord and the celebration of the Son of God who saved mankind; and heaven and earth rejoices. Woe to the one who neglects to observe the great Sunday, for Christ will ignore him on the day of Judgment. Glory to the Son of God, for by his resurrection he exalted Sunday above all other days in the four corners of the world. O Blessed Mary, our Lady, pray to your only Son for us. He will be pleased by your intercession and shower his mercy upon us. Let us all beseech the Lord and pray.

May we always strive to keep holy the Day of the Lord and enter into his courts with praise and thanksgiving.





## Letter from our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

Though this pandemic remains with us, and likely will for some time, the Work of God must and will continue. We have learned to adapt to many changes in our lives over the past five months, yet we continue to work, to meet our obligations to civil authority, to our familes, and to ourselves. Our duty to God is not optional. The worship of the One who created us is essential to our very being.


